INTERNAL AUDITOR - KETTI JOB GROUP K –JOB GRADE 10 (1 Post)

(a) Duties and Responsibilities

An Internal Auditor will administratively and functionally assist the Principal and the Board of Governors.

Specific duties and responsibilities will entail: -

- i. Developing and formulating internal audit policies, regulations, and guidelines, and evaluating their impact;
- ii. Developing and facilitating operationalization of risk management strategies and initiatives to mitigate risks in the institute;
- iii. Developing and implementing annual audit plans for the internal audit unit;
- iv. Spearheading the internal audit function in accordance with obtaining laws and regulations and international auditing standards;
- v. Coordinating regular audits on systems, processes, and procedures
- vi. Coordinating audit assignments;
- vii. Investigating suspected fraudulent and corrupt activities;
- viii. Reviewing internal control and procedures;
- ix. Facilitating compliance with statutes, regulations, and government guidelines;
- x. Updating and maintaining audit records;
- xi. Facilitating operations of external auditors;
- xii. Following up on the implementation of internal audit recommendations;
- xiii. Developing new initiatives aimed at improving internal audit operational efficiencies;
- xiv. Auditing and reviewing of financial statements to ensure compliance with internal financial reporting standards; and
- xv. Supervision, guidance, and development of staff in the unit.
- xvi. Having proven knowledge in Enterprise Resource Planning (ERP) will be an added advantage
- xvii. Perform any other duty assigned by the Principal.

(b) Requirements for Appointment

For appointment to this grade, an officer must have:-

- i. Served in the grade of Internal Auditor I or in a comparable and relevant position for a minimum period of three (3) years;
- ii. Bachelor of Commerce degree (Accounting/Finance option), Auditing, Accounting, Finance, Business Administration (Accounting or Finance Option), or equivalent qualification from a recognized institution;
- iii. Holder of CPA (K) or ACCA or an equivalent;
- iv. Membership to the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya (ICPAK) or a relevant professional body;
- v. A member of the Institute of Internal Auditors (IIA) will be an added advantage
- vi. Certificate in computer applications; and
- vii. Demonstrated merit and ability as reflected in work performance and results.

In compliance with Article six (6) of the Constitution of Kenya, the successful candidate shall provide:

- Valid certificate of good conduct
- Valid Tax Compliance certificate
- HELB Clearance certificate
- Clearance Certificate from the Ethics and Anti-Corruption Commission (EACC)
